## Colorado Horse Park (CHP) & Colorado Equestrian Partners (CEP) RELEASE, WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Every entry at a recognized competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, handler and the horse), For themselves, their principles, representatives, employ-ees and agents: (1) Shall be subject to the constitution and rules of CHP & CEP and the local rules of the competition; (2) Represent that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) Agree to be bound by the constitution and rules of CHP and CEP and of the compe-tition, and will accept as final the decision of CHP and CEP on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition, CHP, CEP their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) Agree that as a condition of and in consideration of accep-tance of entry, they authorize CHP & CEP and/or the competition management to market, trans-fer, assign or otherwise make any use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcast, cable-casts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horses(s) and participants(s) while on the grounds, incident to, on in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the event, sport, CHP or CEP, without com-pensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur state nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misap-proprietion; and (5) Agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk pf serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of in injury or loss, and they agree to hold CHP, CEP, the competition and their officials, directors, employees and agent harmless from and against all claims including claims based on negligence, breach of contract, strict liabil-ity and/or otherwise for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, officials, directors, employees or agents of CHP, CEP or competition. The construction and ap-plication of CEP and CEP rules are governed by the laws of the State of Colorado, and any ac-tion instituted against CHP and/or CEP must be filed in the State of Colorado.

UNDER COLORADO LAW, AN EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES, PURSUANTTO SECTION 13-21-119 COLORADO REVISED STATUTES.
